Information for exchange students

Application procedure

- 1) Complete the *Mobility-Online* application form.
- 2) Check your email box and create your personal online account using the link you received from *Mobility-Online*.
- 3) Upload all the required documents to your *Mobility-Online* account: passport-size photo, ID document (passport or ID card), CV, cover letter, *learning agreement* signed by your home university.

Application period and deadlines

1st semester

- From **mid-February to May 15th** for completing the *Mobility-Online* form and creating your personal online account.
- **May 30th at the latest** for uploading all the documents to your *Mobility-Online* account.

2nd semester

- From **mid-September to November 15th** for completing the *Mobility-Online* form and creating your personal online account.
- **November 30th at the latest** for uploading all the documents to your *Mobility-Online* account.

Language requirements

- **B2** level in French or in English (depending on the language of instruction of your preselected courses).
- We do not require any documents to prove your language level but if you have a language certificate, please join it to your application file.

Housing solutions

- Room in a student residence on campus: apply through the *Mobility-Online* form.
Important to know: this does not guarantee the booking of accommodation – our International Office will inform you if your room request has been accepted or not.
